

“Fun Felt Coasters”



Who knew felt could be so fun? Let your guests drink in style with these incredibly easy-to-make embellished coasters.

Skill Level: Beginner

Supplies:

Baby Lock Embellisher

9" x 12" rectangles of felt: white, dark blue, light blue, olive green and tan
Pinking shears or rotary cutter with pinking or wavy blade
Scissors

Instructions:

1. Cut eight 4-1/2" squares from the white felt.

2. Cut small circles in assorted sizes from each of the colors.
3. Arrange these on one of the white squares.
4. Cut two 3" flowers from the shades of blue.
5. Cut two small circles for the flower centers.
6. Arrange the flowers and flower centers on another white square.
7. Cut small assorted size rectangles from each of the colors.
8. Arrange these on a white square.
9. Using the pinking shears or rotary blade cut four wavy strips of felt, one in each color.
10. Weave and layer the strips on a white square.
11. Once all the shapes are cut and positioned on top of the white squares, use the Baby Lock embellisher to secure them in place by needle felting them in position.

Note: *The more times you felt over an area, the tighter the pieces will hold together.*

Optional Technique: *For added interest, you can hand stitch around the shapes using a running stitch. Keep the stitches about twice as long as the spaces between them. Knot the thread on the wrong side at the end of the last stitch.*

12. Place a second white square on the wrong side of each of the white squares and embellish around the outer edge to secure.
