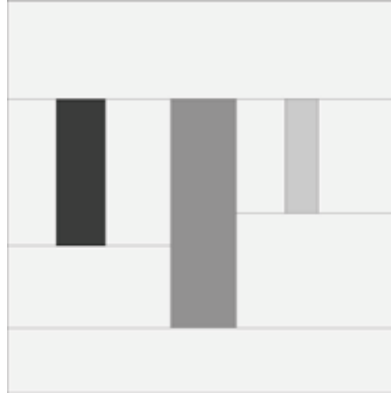


## Projects

### ICICLES



This simple block pattern can be made with a variety of Fabrics and is simple enough for any quilter. Twist and turn your blocks to see which design you like best!

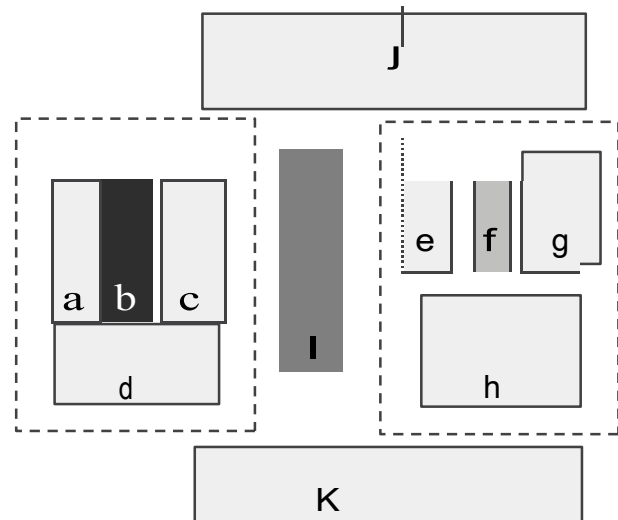

#### Block Construction:

From a background fabric, cut:  
 1- 1/2" x 6- 1/2" rectangle (K)  
 2" x 6- 1/2" rectangle (J)  
 1- 3/4" x 2- 1/4" rectangle (G)  
 2- 1/4" x 3" rectangle (H)  
 1- 3/4" x 3" rectangle (D)  
 1- 1/4" x 2- 3/4" rectangle (A)  
 1- 1/2" x 2- 3/4" rectangle (C)  
 1 1/4" x 2 1/4" rectangle (E)

From a light, medium or dark fabric, cut:

1- 1/4" x 2- 3/4" rectangle (B)  
 1- 1/2" x 4" rectangle (I)  
 1" x 2- 1/4" rectangle (F)



#### Instructions:

1. As you cut layout the pieces as shown in the diagram. Sew A-C together, pressing the seam allowances toward the dark. Then sew the A-C unit to piece D.
2. In the same manner, sew pieces E-H together.
3. Sew A-D and E-H to either side of piece I, press the seam allowances toward the center.
4. Sew the top (J) and bottom (K) pieces in place, press the seam allowances
